

The following research on Illuminated Manuscripts, pre-dated by Cultural Codex or Codices, Ledger Art, Post-Modernity, Children's Picture Books, the Icon and Web 1, 2 and 3 technology including Blockchain and the Distributed Ledger, illustrates a constant linkage between recordation and verification.

Presented to my Summer Session 1 students, this lecture includes personal insights on the importance of records, signatures and ownership. The synergy, phonetic and linguistic similarities and timeline of this Human Ledger, is in no small way a coincidence or folly. Take for instance the irony inherent in Ledger Art and Ledger "Not Your Keys, Not Your Coins". Or for example, the connection between Regan-Era economics such as the term "I'd buy that for a dollar," (<u>https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/RoboCop</u>) and the emergence of the Buy/Sell/Trade economy with the *lcon* such as Topps **®** *Garbage Pail Kids*. Not to mention other linguistic connections between history and technology, *Real World Assets* (RWA,) a term drawn from decentralized finance etymologically for example, means raw or *raw* flesh, such as the pages of catgut, kid and calf hand-bound manuscripts.

Web 1, 2 and 3: the Read, Write, Own era of Information Technology converging with Sociology tempered by Financial Technology within the backdrop of burgeoning developments in Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Blockchain, marks our social and economic trajectory.

This *mark* or X, also see: <u>aleph</u> is quite synergistic and beautiful with its codification, as the logic language of Ethereum and its prefix, 0x is visually identical to the Hebrew and Egyptian Ox and the widely used Tav or Taw and the hieroglyph X.
